Dear Parents/Carers,

We have joined up with the Church of England 'Faith at Home' campaign to record a song for our community during this period of Lockdown. The song is called 'Looking to the Rainbow' and we need your help! You can watch the song here;

On the school website is a link to the song, the lyrics to the song and a link to a website with a backing track of the song on. We would love it if you would learn the song with the children in your home and then record them singing it over the backing track. This sounds complicated but if you follow these instructions it hopefully should be easy enough.

- 1) Download the backing track to a phone or tablet – or play the song on YouTube. On the website there are two backing tracks – you need the one entitled 'Backing track + calls'
- 2) When your child knows the song, let them listen to it through headphones so the backing music cannot be heard.
- 3) Film them on your phone or tablet (landscape mode please!) making sure the only noise recorded is their voice!
- 4) When you film it ask your child to clap along to the four beats at the beginning of the song only – this will help me when putting it together!
- 5) When you've finished simply email it direct from your phone or tablet to the homework email address for attention of Mr Harding ([homework@stml.bolton.gov.uk](mailto:homework@stml.bolton.gov.uk))
